The Resurection

We have chosen Thee to be our most mighty Trumpet, Whose blast is to signalize the resurrection of all mankind. Gleanings 31

Therefore, we say that the meaning of Christ's resurrection is as follows: the disciples were troubled and agitated after the martyrdom of Christ. The Reality of, which signifies His teachings, His bounties, His perfections and His spiritual power, was hidden and concealed for two or three days after His martyrdom, and was not resplendent and manifest. No, rather it was lost, for the believers were few in number and were troubled and agitated. The Cause of Christ was like a lifeless body; and when after three days the disciples became assured and steadfast, and began to serve the Cause of Christ, and resolved to spread the divine teachings, put His councils into practice, and arising to serve Him, the Reality of Christ became resplendent and His bounty appeared; His religion found life; His teachings and His admonitions became evident and visible. In other words, the Cause of Christ was like a lifeless body until the life and the bounty of the Holy Spirit surrounded it.

Such is the meaning of the resurrection of Christ, and this was a true resurrection. But as the clergy have neither understood the meaning of the Gospels nor comprehended the symbols...

SAQ 104-5

The resurrection of the Divine Manifestations are not of the body. All Their states, Their conditions...and Their instructions have a spiritual and divine significance, and have no connection with material things

SAQ 103

The Day He revealeth Himself is Resurrection Day which shall last as long as He ordaineth.

The Bab 157-8

What is meant by the Day of resurrection is this, that from the time of the appearance of Him Who is the Tree of divine reality, at whatever period and under whatever name, until the moment of His disappearance, is the Day of Resurrection.

For example, from the inception of the mission of Jesus - may peace be upon Him - till the day of His ascension was the Resurrection of Moses. For during that period the Revelation of God shone forth through the appearance of that divine Reality, Who rewarded by His Word everyone who believed in Moses...

And from the inception of the Revelation of the Apostle of God - may the blessings of God be upon Him - till the day of His ascension was the resurrection of Jesus...

The Bab 106-7

How vast the number of people who will, on the Day of Resurrection, regard themselves to be in the right, while they shall be accounted as false through the Dispensation of

Providence, inasmuch as they will shut themselves out as by a veil from Him Whom God shall make Manifest and refuse to bow down in adoration before Him Who, as divinely ordained in the Book, is the object of their creation.

The Bab 143

Reflect, can a more precious, a mightier, and more glorious day than this be conceived, so that man should willingly forego its grace, and deprive himself of its bounties, which like unto vernal showers are raining down from the heaven of mercy upon all mankind?

Having thus conclusively demonstrated that no day is greater than this Day, and no revelation more glorious than this Revelation, and having set forth all these weighty and infallible proofs which no understanding mind can question, and no man of learning overlook, how can man possibly, through the idle contention of the people of doubt and fancy, deprive himself of such a bountiful grace?...

Strive, therefore, O my brother, to grasp the meaning of "Resurrection," and cleanse thine ears from the idle sayings of these rejected people. Shouldst thou step into the realm of detachment, thou wilt readily testify that no day is greater than this Day...One righteous work performed in this Day, equalleth all the virtuous acts which for myriads of centuries men have practised - nay, We ask forgiveness of God for such a comparison! For verily the reward which such a deed deserveth is immensely beyond and above the estimate of men.

KI 143-5

Return and Reincarnation (Not Transmigration of the soul)

Strive therefore to comprehend the meaning of "return"...If thou sayest that Muhammad was the "return" of the Prophets of old...His Companions must likewise be the "return" of the bygone Companions...In like manner, endeavour to grasp the significance of "return," "revelation," and "resurrection," as witnessed in the days of the Manifestations of the divine Essence, that thou mayest behold with thine own eyes the "return" of the holy souls into sanctified bodies...Inasmuch as the return of the Prophets of God, as attested by verses and traditions, hath been conclusively demonstrated, the return of their chosen ones also is therefore definitely proven. This return is too manifest in itself to require any evidence or proof.

These same people...as soon as they drank the immortal draught of faith, from the cup of certitude...were so transformed that they would renounce for His sake their kindred, their substance, their lives, their beliefs, yea, all else save God! So over powering was their yearning for God, so uplifting their transports of delight, that the world and all that is therein faded before their eyes into nothingness. Have not this people exemplified the mysteries of "rebirth" and "return"?

Therefore, those who in every subsequent Dispensation preceded the rest of mankind in embracing the Faith of God, who quaffed the clear waters of knowledge at the hand of the divine Beauty, and attained the loftiest summits of faith and certitude, these can be regarded, in name, in reality, in deeds, in words, and in rank, as the "return" of those who in a former Dispensation had achieved similar distinctions...These lights have proceeded from but one Source, and these fruits are the fruits of one Tree. Thou canst discern neither difference nor distinction among them. All this is by the grace of God.
